# Peru 2022

In August, 2022, the KCE team (Dr. Ron Dieckmann, Dr. Stevan Cavalier, Drew Kemp, and Kerry McCulloch) trained more than 360 doctors across six hospitals and clinics in Peru. The first stop was revisiting colleagues and training a new cohort of clinicians in Peru's capital city, Lima. We returned to *Hospital Dos de Mayo*, Peru's oldest public hospital, located in an extremely resource-poor neighborhood of Lima. The KCE team also began a new collaboration at the maternal and child health clinic, *Centro Materno Infantil Virgen del Carmen*.

The group visited colleagues in the Northern rural region of Cajamarca for the first time in August, 2022. KCE connected with two regional health leaders to conduct *DynaMed* trainings at three hospitals and to develop a train-the-trainer program to provide a sustainable *DynaMed* training program in this region.
